## INK POWDER.

*DIRECTIONS.* Take one gill of vinegar—three gills of rain or river water and one packet of Ink Powder—mix them thoroughly in a vessel of glass or stone ware, and the Ink will soon be fit for common use. For the more important purposes however in which great *beauty* and *durability* are requisite, it should be allowed to stand two or three weeks, being kept moderately warm and often stirred. N.B. Ink should be kept from freezing.

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
